There was a larger yarding of 3,213 lambs at Powranna on Tuesday with more shorn pens included but still most in the wool and still in good to very good condition. Most lambs met a fully firm market pushed by regular exporters and wholesalers plus very strong restocker competition mainly in the 18 to 22 kg range. There was a similar number of 3,033 mutton and although extra heavy sheep met a similar market, medium and heavy sheep were \$10 to \$15/head dearer.

Restockers bought light lambs from \$128 to \$150, light trade sold from \$148 to \$173 and trade weights made from \$156 to \$181/head. Processors paid from \$160 to \$180 for light trade whilst the trade weights sold \$160 to \$192, the heavy weights made from \$180 to \$218 and extra heavy pens sold from \$217 to \$230/head for extra heavy pens.

Extra heavy ewes over 30kg made from \$148 to \$164, heavy ewes and wethers sold from \$154 to \$171 and medium weights with big skins sold from \$124 to \$170/head. Restockers paid from \$136 to \$166/head for ewes still suitable as breeders.
