There was a slightly smaller yarding of 2,400 lambs at Powranna on Tuesday with not as weight as last week. The market improved across all grades with heavy lambs up as much as \$20/head. There was also a slightly smaller yarding of 2,527 mutton and this market was erratic with fewer buyers and most sheep prices eased \$5 to \$10/head.

Restockers bought light lambs from \$134 to \$162 and light trade sold from \$157 to \$176/head. Light trade to processors sold from \$155 to \$174 whilst trade lambs made from \$174 to \$196/head. The heavy pens to 30kg sold from \$198 to \$218/head.

Extra heavy ewes made from \$150 to \$174 whilst heavies sold from \$145 to \$176/head. Medium weights were making from \$119 to \$155 and lights sold from \$96 to \$116/head. Restockers bought light sheep from \$100 to \$125/head.
