There was a much larger yarding of 3,142 lambs at Powranna on Tuesday and although not the weight at the top end quality was good throughout the sale. Competition was not as strong from exporters with rough weather affecting the shipping across Bass Strait and most heavy pens lost last week's gains to be \$10 to \$20/head cheaper. Most trade and light trade lambs met a similar market even with the absence of one regular Victorian wholesaler.

Restockers bought light lambs for \$122 to \$158, light trade \$155 to \$168 and trade \$167 to \$178/head. Processors paid \$168 to \$182 for trade lambs, \$188 to \$214 for heavy and a few extra heavy pens made \$210 to \$218/head.

There was also a much larger yarding of 3,115 mutton with many drafts of heavy and extra heavy ewesincluded. The market eased \$2 to \$5/head but still recorded strong sales. Extra heavy ewes made \$180 to \$225, heavy \$170 to \$188, medium \$139 to \$170, light \$122 to \$133 and very light \$85 to \$104/head. Restockers bought wethers in the wool for \$176 to \$188/head.
