There was a larger yarding of 3,633 lambs at Powranna on Tuesday with less weight and many more store lambs and for the first time for some months there were numbers of very small lambs included. There were few heavy lambs and the market for trade and heavy trade was \$5 to \$7/head cheaper while most restocking lambs also saw an easier trend.

Restockers bought very small lambs for \$44 to \$120, light \$134 to \$154, light trade \$144 to \$163 and trade \$164 to \$170/head. The trade paid \$144 to \$163 for light trade, \$160 to \$184 for trade, \$176 to \$220 for heavy pens.

There was a smaller yarding of 2,206 mutton (909 less) with fewer extra heavy crossbred ewes included. Competition was erratic with generally less buyer interest and most sheep averaged \$20 to \$30/head cheaper. Extra heavy sheep made \$160 to \$176, heavy \$140 to \$166, medium \$100 to \$154, light \$85 to \$144 and very light \$70 to \$75/head
