There was a slightly smaller yarding of 2,390 lambs at Powranna on Tuesday. There were many good quality pens of lambs in the 23 to 28kg range. With an additional buyer and good quality on offer, heavy lambs sold \$10 to \$12 dearer, while most of the lighter lambs eased \$3 to \$5/head.

Light weight lambs to restockers made from \$100 to \$122, while light trade lambs sold from \$150 to \$181 and trade weights made from \$168 to \$174/head. Processors paid from \$95 to \$120 for light lambs and from \$136 to \$166/head for light trade weights. Heavy pens going to processors made from \$186 to \$212/head.

Extra heavy ewes made from \$188 to \$202/head. The small supply of 1,200 mutton and extra interest saw the price of most sheep improve by \$20 to \$30/head.
