This week there was a similar number of lambs with more store lambs and fewer trade weights available. The market was weaker and lost most of last week's gains to be \$5 to \$10/head cheaper. There was a much smaller yarding of mutton and this market also fell \$10 to \$20/head off the highs of last week.

Restockers bought light lambs, paying from \$110 to \$158, while light trade weights sold from \$147 to \$180/head. Processors bought light lambs from \$100 to \$139 and light trades from \$140 to \$166/head. Trade weight lambs to process buyers sold from \$172 to \$186 and heavy 24 to 30kg lambs made from \$191 to \$228/head.

Extra heavy ewes made from \$184 to \$222 while heavy weights reached a top of \$190/head. Medium ewes ranged from \$144 to \$178 with light sheep making from \$115 to \$135 and very light sheep reaching \$85/head.
