There was a much smaller yarding of 1,543 lambs at Powranna on Tuesday. There were fewer light store lambs in a market that was generally \$3 to \$7/head cheaper with the exception of the best trade lambs that were fully firm. There was little restocker competition with most light trade pens being sold to processors. There was a larger yarding of 1,785 mutton and after last weeks very strong market most prices eased \$10 to \$15/head although all buyers were active.

Restockers bought very small lambs from \$68 to \$72, while light lambs made from \$112 to \$130 and light trades made from \$140 to \$163/head. Light lambs to processors sold from \$110 to \$120 with light trades making from \$134 to \$177/head. Processors paid from \$152 to \$177 for trade weights whilst heavy trades made from \$176 to \$194 and extra heavy pens made to a top of \$206/head.

Extra heavy mutton made from \$170 to \$200 whilst heavy weights made a top of \$184/head. Medium weight ewes sold from \$118 to \$168 and light weights sold from \$82 to \$137/head.
